Epilepsy Essentials

Living with Epilepsy and Disability

(online only)

Emergency Medications: Theory and Practical

This course offers theory and practical video assessment. Completion of Epilepsy Essentials is a must, and it is recommended to have a current first aid or CPR certificate.

This course is perfect for anyone in the disability sector and uses many video examples.

This course does not cover seizure first aid.

Observing and Recording Seizures

(online only)

Learn what to look for and document when managing seizures. Perfect for healthcare and support workers who want to sharpen up their skills.

This course has been highly commended by disability support organisations for the interactive and engaging activities to practice the challenging area of effective documentation.

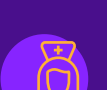
